

Additional Information:

Each exhibitor or family can bring their own pig; however it is not required. We encourage you to bring your pig so that we can provide a customized feeding program that specifically targets the areas that can help maximize your pig's genetic potential and make him/her look their best, it is also a great advantage during the showmanship portions for us to be able to work with you and your pig. If you do decide to bring your gilt or barrow, we will provide a pen with a self-water and shavings. Bring your own feed.

For those families that decide not to bring a pig, we will have a few pigs that exhibitors can use during the portions of the camp where a live animal is needed (showmanship, etc) so that everyone can have a hands on experience and learn as much as possible to take home and apply! However, please consider bringing your own pig.

We are anxious to work with each and every exhibitor that will be attending the camp, regardless of age or experience. With that said, some of the material that we cover may be better retained by an adult (medicine use, withdrawals, etc). We do believe that it will truly be advantageous and that your family may benefit even more from this camp if at least one parent/guardian also attends the camp with their exhibitor(s).

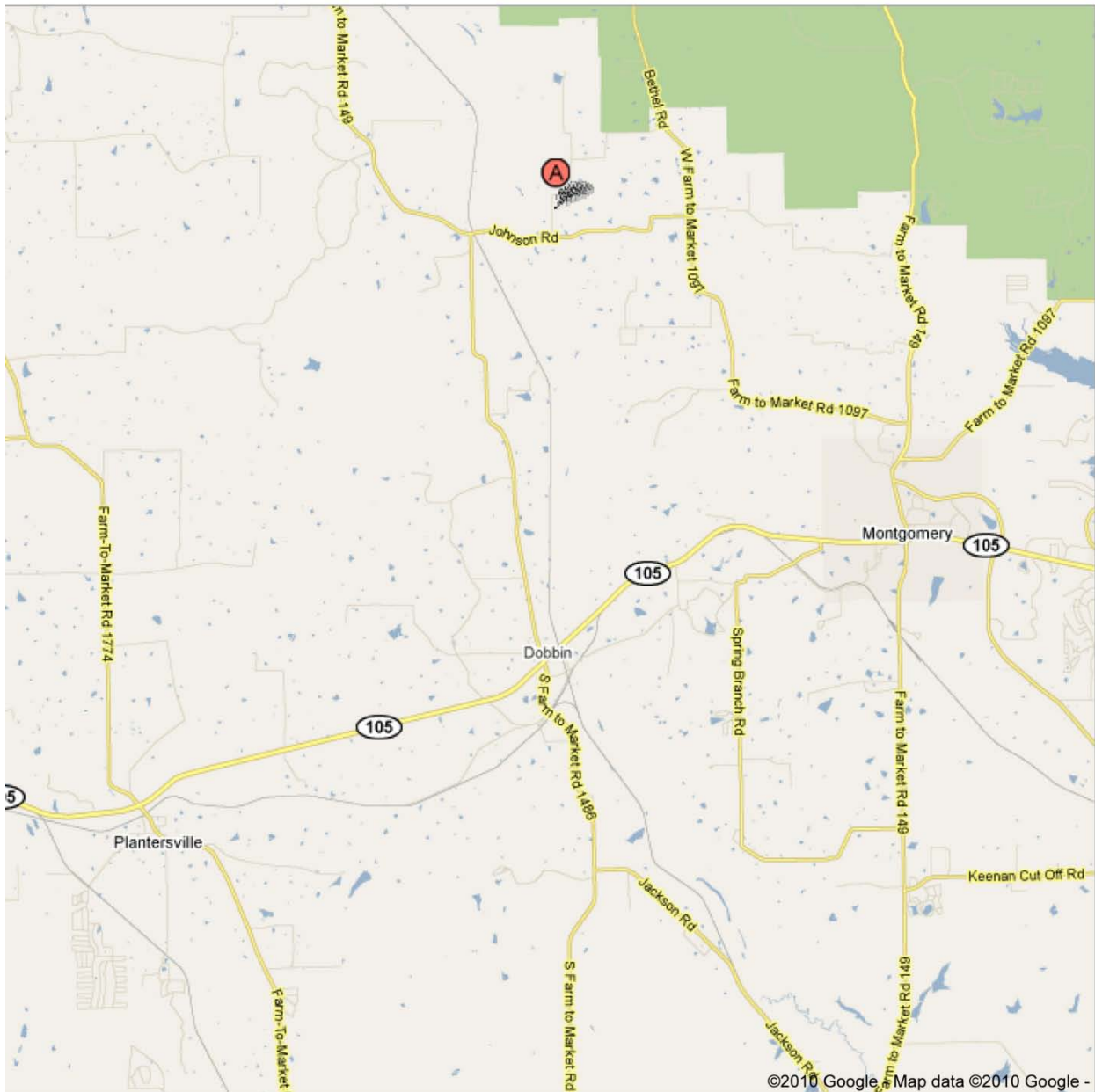
From Highway 6 in Navasota:

- Take Highway 105 East to Dobbin
- Take a left and go North on FM 1486 in Dobbin at the blinking light
- Go 6 miles to Dacus
- In Dacus, take a right and go East on Johnson Road..Johnson turn off of 1486 in the large curve in Dacus IN FRONT OF JORGE's convenience store.
- Take Johnson Rd. over the railroad tracks, then over the wooden bridge, and turn left on Bethel Road (only black top off of Johnson and runs between a group of ranchette style houses)
- Take Bethel for ¼ mile, the road turns to the right, take the turn and start looking to the left. Red Brick house and barns in back. We will have a sign in front of the place.

From 1-45 in Conroe:

- Take Highway 105 West to Dobbin (past Montgomery)

- Take a Right and go North on FM 1486 in Dobbin at the blinking light
- Go 6 miles to Dacus
- In Dacus, take a right and go East on Johnson Road..Johnson turn off of 1486 in the large curve in Dacus IN FRONT OF JORGE's convenience store.
- Take Johnson Rd. over the railroad tracks, then over the wooden bridge, and turn left on Bethel Road (only black top off of Johnson and runs between a group of ranchette style houses)
